TENNIS GOLD COAST FEES: TENNIS GOLD COAST Registration must be paid before Floater or Casual plays their third match.

Casual Team Player (or Floater)

Any player not included on the team registration form and who subsequently plays in a fixture team is deemed to be a CASUAL FLOATER. A casual player may play in any team within a section or sections subject to the following rules.

a. A player is not considered eligible for a team if in the opinion of the Fixture & Grading Committee the player would make the team too strong, or is graded higher than the majority of players in that section.

b. The player's full details must be entered on the scorecard and entered as a player in Competition Planner for the player to be identified.

c. A casual player must pay their Tennis Gold Coast registration fees before the commencement of their third match otherwise the team they play in will lose points for the sets this player plays in.

d. A casual player may play semi's and/or finals for which team he/she has received approval from the Fixture & Grading Committee, or if they have played three (3) matches for this team in the season.

e. No player may play in a lower section than the one in which he/she first played except after receiving approval from the Fixture & Grading Committee. A player may reserve in a higher section/s providing that the player plays **NO MORE THAN TWO (2) MATCHES**. If a third match is played in a higher section then the casual player is ineligible to return to their original lower section for the remainder of the current season.

A WIN CAN ONLY BE OBTAINED IF:

1. Play is continuous for stipulated time.
2. 2 sets are completed (due to rain interrupted play) or a team is in an unbeatable position.
